THE JERSEY. You can all wear the same jersey to the big match. The red-and-white jerseys will brighten up the whole stadium.

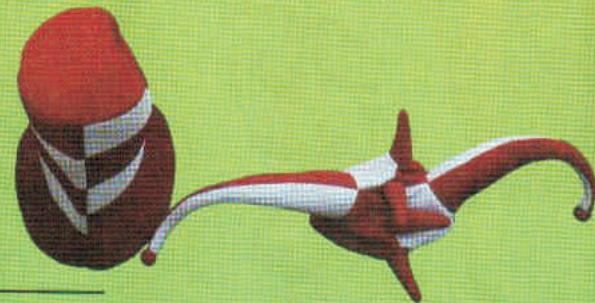


THE JACKET. You might feel a bit cold when you are heading home from the stadium. The team's jacket will look cool on you. Choose your colors: red, green, or black.
